The Filipino American Voice United (FAVU) and the Federation of Philippine American Chambers of Commerce (FPACC) organized "Call to Action and Unity of Fil-Am Communities: Humanitarian Response to the Philippine COVID-19 Crisis" on April 21 via Zoom. Guest speakers included Ambassador



Jose Manual Romualdez and Senator Manny Pacquiao. The meeting was attended by around 75 leaders across the country, including some PACCGA board members, Jane Rolen, Eleanor Pascual, Ann Marie Logarta and Pia Valeriano. Attendees discussed how the Fil-Am community can unite to respond to the COVID crisis in the Philippines. The group was encouraged to sign the petition to request President Biden to facilitate immediate release of 20 million doses of Moderna COVID Vaccines to the Philippines. It was also discussed to encourage Fil-Am organizations and individuals to contact State Representatives and other influencers to send COVID vaccine to the Philippines.
